Description

In this event, participants can perform Gujarati Doha, Chand, Drama, Poem, Historical events, Religious events, Instrumental performance and Gujarati folk dance. Such events are an opportunity for theatre enthusiasts to experience the richness of Gujarati language and culture, as well as for artists to showcase their talents.

General Rules

1. Students of any stream can take part in this event.
2. Participants can compete individually or in teams of up to 7 members.
3. Details of performance and team members must be provided during registration.
4. The performance must be in Gujarati, focusing on themes relevant to Gujarati culture and literature.
5. Each performance should be 02 to 10 minutes long.
6. Teams are responsible for bringing their own props, costumes, and any other necessary materials.
7. Content should be appropriate for all audiences and should not include offensive or controversial material.
8. Participants must respect the time slots allocated to them and avoid causing delays.
9. Professional behaviour is expected at all times. Disruptive behaviour may lead to disqualification.
10. Judges' decisions will be final.
11. Reporting time will be 08:30 AM on the day of Event.
