Description

General Rules

1. There are a maximum of **5 players** allowed in **one team**.
2. A maximum of **16 teams** can register for the game.
3. There are three playing rounds (**1st Knockout, 2nd Semifinal & 3rd Final**) included in the event.
4. Online registered 16 teams (**First come first serve based**) are considered for the game.
5. The online registered team must do the reporting on the day of the event (**14/09/2024**) at the event location (**Near Mechanical Workshop**) to the student coordinators.
6. When the online registered team completes their reporting to the student coordinator, they need to pay **registration fees (offline mode) of 150 Rs, per team**.
7. Each inning includes **5 overs**. 1 bowler can bowl a maximum of 2 overs. The wicketkeeper can't bowl the over.
8. Each match should be complete within **30 minutes (maximum)** otherwise a penalty will be applicable as decided by the on-field umpire.
9. The umpire decision will be considered as the final decision.
10. The other rules will be discussed on the field with the team players.
