

# Event: MindQuest

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## Description

MindQuest is a quiz competition designed for IT enthusiastic students who are passionate about technology. It will help test their knowledge on the latest tech trends and dive into the ultimate quest of information technology and its related areas with this engaging quiz event.

Participants in groups of three will tackle challenging questions on various IT topics including fundamentals of the IT field, software, hardware, programming, networking, emerging technologies, trending topics and general information about the IT field.

Students from the computer related courses can only participate.

## General Rules

1. Group participation is only allowed. Total 3 participants per group will be allowed to participate on a first come first serve basis.
2. Basic knowledge of the IT field and related areas is required.
3. There will be four rounds in the competition.
4. Winner, 1st and 2nd Runners of the event will be decided based on the final round.
5. The decision taken by the Institute and Event coordinators/Judges will be considered as final.
6. Reporting time will be 8:30 AM on the day of Event.

## Quiz Rounds

### 1. First Round (Mind Spark)

- Each team will be asked 30 questions (objective questions).
- 5 marks for correct answer, and no negative marking for wrong answer.
- First 20 groups will be selected for the second round.
- The answering time is only 20 minutes.
- This is the elimination round.

### 2. Second Round (Sonic Vision)

- This round will be the audio-visual round.
- Each team will be asked 2 audio-visual questions.
- Audio-visual will be played for 60 seconds and answering time is only 30 seconds.

- If a team cannot answer the question, then the question would be forwarded to the next team and 2 marks for correct answer will be given.
- 10 marks for the correct answer and -5 for the wrong or no answer.
- 5 teams are to be selected for the final round.

### **3. Third Round (Ultimate Showdown)**

- Total 25 questions will be asked.
- Team has to answer immediately after pressing the buzzer.
- 10 marks for the correct answer and -5 for the wrong or no answer.
- Final Judgement will be determined by Officials/Judges.
- 3 teams are to be selected as Winners, 1st and 2nd Runners.
